Summary (as of Jul 31, 2019)

Rural America Health Corps Act

This bill requires the Health Resources and Services Administration to establish a demonstration project under the National Health Service Corps Loan Repayment Program to increase the number of health care providers in rural areas. Specifically, eligible participants who agree to serve for 5 years in such a rural area may receive up to \$25,000 in loan repayments for each year of service.
