Summary (as of Apr 30, 2019)

Record Expungement Designed to Enhance Employment Act of 2019 or the REDEEM Act

This bill establishes processes for the sealing and expungement of criminal records related to nonviolent offenses. It also generally prohibits room confinement (i.e., solitary confinement) for juveniles, restores access to specified federal benefits for individuals convicted of certain drug-related offenses, and directs the Department of Justice to take specified actions with respect to criminal records.

Actions Timeline

- **May 20, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **May 16, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Nutrition, Oversight, and Department Operations.
- **Apr 30, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 30, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committees on Agriculture, and Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
