## **Future Defense Artificial Intelligence Technology Assessment Act or the Future DATA Act**

This bill directs the Department of Defense (DOD) to report on its artificial intelligence (AI) strategy.

The report shall include

- an analysis of the increasing use of AI by DOD,
- identification of any data gaps,
- identification of applicable ethical guidelines,
- plans to protect systems from bad actors,
- expected benefits of AI for Armed Forces operations, and
- plans for collaboration.

- **May 1, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **May 1, 2019:** Referred to the House Committee on Armed Services.
