Opioid Workforce Act of 2019

This bill increases the number of residency positions eligible for graduate medical education payments under Medicare for hospitals that have addiction or pain management programs, with an aggregate increase of 1,000 positions over a five-year period.

Actions Timeline

- **May 2, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 1, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **May 1, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
