Summary (as of Nov 5, 2019)

Reauthorizing Security for Supreme Court Justices Act

This bill permanently authorizes the Marshal of the Supreme Court and the Supreme Court Police to provide security protection for Supreme Court Justices (and their official guests) and officers and employees of the Supreme Court. Additionally, it permits such protection to be provided in any location—not just in any state.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 5, 2019:** Committee on the Judiciary. Reported by Senator Graham with an amendment in the nature of a substitute. Without written report.
- **Nov 5, 2019:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 282.
- **Oct 31, 2019:** Committee on the Judiciary. Ordered to be reported with an amendment in the nature of a substitute favorably.
- **Sep 19, 2019:** Introduced in Senate
- **Sep 19, 2019:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.
