Summary (as of May 10, 2019)

All-of-the-Above Federal Building Energy Conservation Act of 2019

This bill revises energy performance requirements for federal buildings, including by requiring agencies to begin installing energy and conservation measures that are life-cycle cost effective.

Actions Timeline

- **May 13, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **May 13, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **May 10, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **May 10, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
