New START Treaty Improvement Act of 2019

This bill prohibits extending the Measures for the Further Reduction and Limitation of Strategic Offensive Arms (New START treaty) or any successor agreement unless the agreement (1) includes and is signed by China, and (2) covers all Russian strategic and non-strategic nuclear forces.

(The New START treaty between the United States and Russia is set to expire in February 2021 but may be extended to February 2026.)

Actions Timeline

- **May 15, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Strategic Forces.
- **May 14, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **May 14, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
