Banning Smoking on Amtrak Act of 2019

This bill prohibits smoking on board National Railroad Passenger Corporation (Amtrak) trains, including smoking electronic cigarettes.

- **Dec 17, 2019:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Dec 16, 2019:** Ms. Norton moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.

- **Dec 16, 2019:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 2726.
- **Dec 16, 2019:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Ms. Norton objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was considered as withdrawn.
