Lessening Addiction By Enhancing Labeling Opioids Act of 2019 or the LABEL Opioids Act

This bill requires prescription opioids to contain a warning label specifying that the opioids may cause dependence, addiction, and overdose.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 26, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **May 15, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 14, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **May 14, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
