Summary (as of May 15, 2019)

Justice for Servicemembers Act

This bill prohibits a predispute arbitration agreement from being valid or enforceable if it requires arbitration of a dispute related to the employment or reemployment rights of a uniformed service member.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 26, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Antitrust, Commercial, and Administrative Law.
- **Jun 11, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.
- **May 15, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **May 15, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
