Creating Lower cost Alternative for Your prescription drugs Act or the CLAY Act

This bill eliminates co-payments for generic drugs for low-income individuals who receive subsidies under the Medicare prescription drug benefit.

- **May 15, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
