Summary (as of May 16, 2019)

Secure Every Child Under the Right Equipment Standards Act of 2019 or the SECURES Act of 2019

This bill directs the Department of Transportation to publish a notice of proposed rulemaking on new federal standards for school bus seat belt requirements on all school buses, regardless of gross vehicle weight rating.
