- **Jan 8, 2019:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 116-1, by Mr. McGovern.
- **Jan 8, 2019:** The rule provides one hour of debate, orders the previous question, and allows one motion to commit on each bill. The rule waives the requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the Committee on Rules on the same day it is presented to the House with respect to any resolution reported through the legislative day of January 15, 2019, relating to a measure making or continuing appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019.
- **Jan 8, 2019:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 1.
