Protecting Officers of the Law In Civilian Establishments Act of 2019 or the POLICE Act of 2019

This bill modifies federal restrictions on the possession of a firearm or dangerous weapon in a federal facility.

Specifically, it permits uniformed law enforcement officers to carry agency-issued firearms and dangerous weapons in certain publicly accessible federal facilities.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 26, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **May 16, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **May 16, 2019:** Referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary.
