Summary (as of May 16, 2019)

Improving Access to Nutrition Act of 2019

This bill repeals certain work requirements for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, formerly known as the food stamp program). (Under current law, the requirements apply to able-bodied adults who are ages 18-49 and have no dependent children. Individuals who do not meet certain work requirements are generally prohibited from receiving more than 3 months of SNAP benefits over a 36-month period.)

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 10, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Nutrition, Oversight, and Department Operations.
- **May 16, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **May 16, 2019:** Referred to the House Committee on Agriculture.
