Summary (as of Nov 14, 2019)

Rural Broadband Investment Tax Credit Act

This bill allows a new tax credit for up to 10% of investment in qualifying broadband projects, subject to specified limitations. The bill includes in the definition of *qualifying broadband project* any project that is designed solely to provide broadband service to one or more rural areas in which more than 50% of households lack access to adequate broadband service.
