Summary (as of May 22, 2019)

Chief Manufacturing Officer Act

This bill directs the President to appoint a United States Chief Manufacturing Officer who shall (1) coordinate manufacturing-related policies and activities across agencies; and (2) create and submit a national manufacturing strategy to develop the manufacturing sector, encourage economic growth, and promote the competitiveness of U.S. manufacturing.

- **May 23, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Consumer Protection and Commerce.
- **May 22, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **May 22, 2019:** Referred to the House Committee on Energy and Commerce.
