This resolution (1) sets forth the rule for consideration of H.R. 1644 (Save the Internet Act of 2019) and for H.R. 2021 (Investing for the People Act of 2019), (2) adopts H.Res. 293 (enforcing the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 for FY2020), and (3) provides for specified congressional procedures on any legislative day from April 11, 2019, through April 26, 2019.

- **Apr 9, 2019:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 294.
- **Apr 9, 2019:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 294, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question, and announced by voice vote, that the yeas had prevailed. Mr. Morelle demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings until later in the legislative day.
- **Apr 9, 2019:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H3166-3168)
- **Apr 9, 2019:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 225 - 192 (Roll no. 160). (consideration: CR H3166-3167)
- **Apr 9, 2019:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 219 - 201 (Roll no. 161).(text: CR H3141)

The rule provides for adoption of H.Res. 293. The rule provides for proceedings during the period of April 11, 2019, through April 26, 2019.
