Summary (as of May 24, 2019)

Non-Emergency Ambulance Transportation Sustainability and Accountability Act of 2019 or the NEATSA Act

This bill decreases the percentage by which Medicare payments must be reduced for nonemergency ambulance transports of end-stage renal disease patients that are provided beginning on October 1, 2019, and ending December 31, 2019. Beginning in 2020, the bill increases the percentage reduction for certain providers that mostly furnish such services, as designated by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). The CMS must publish data regarding such payments and providers on its website.

Actions Timeline

- **May 27, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 24, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **May 24, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
