Summary (as of May 28, 2019)

Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Extension Act of 2019

This bill reauthorizes through FY2029 the Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Trust Fund, which supports research that evaluates and compares outcomes and the clinical effectiveness, risks, and benefits of two or more medical treatments, services, or other health practices.

Additionally, the bill extends specified fees on private health insurance plans, including self-insured plans, which support the trust.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 4, 2019:** Subcommittee Hearings Held.
- **May 29, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 28, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **May 28, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
