Summary (as of May 28, 2019)

Reserve Medical Officer Parity Act

This bill authorizes a military department, on a case-by-case basis, to retain in an active status a reserve officer in one of several medical specialties beyond the age of 68 if the department determines that such retention is necessary to the department concerned.
