## **Make State Governments More Open, Honest, and Transparent Act of 2019**

This bill requires the head of a federal agency that administers any of specified block grant programs to suspend the authority of a state to administer funds under a program if the state does not enact or enforce at least one law that (1) requires disclosure by a state legislator of financial interests, (2) prohibits a legislator from soliciting political party or election campaign contributions, or (3) prohibits the making or soliciting of contributions during a period of contractor performance or negotiations.

### **Actions Timeline**

- **Jun 7, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Emergency Preparedness, Response, and Recovery.
- **Jun 4, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Aviation.
- **Jun 4, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Highways and Transit.
- **Jun 4, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jun 3, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 3, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Education and Labor, Financial Services, Homeland Security, the Judiciary, Transportation and Infrastructure, and Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
