DHS Cyber Hunt and Incident Response Teams Act of 2019

This bill requires the Department of Homeland Security's National Cybersecurity and Communications Integration Center to maintain cyber-hunt and incident-response teams to assist with activities such as restoring services following a cyber incident and identifying cybersecurity risks and unauthorized cyber activity.

Actions Timeline

- **Apr 8, 2019:** Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs. Reported by Senator Johnson with an amendment in the nature of a substitute. With written report No. 116-27.
- **Apr 8, 2019:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 62.
- **Feb 13, 2019:** Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs. Ordered to be reported with an amendment in the nature of a substitute favorably.
- **Jan 31, 2019:** Introduced in Senate
