Summary (as of Jun 10, 2019)

This bill requires the Department of Defense to provide a death gratuity, casualty assistance, and life insurance to the survivors of a graduate of the Reserve Officers' Training Corps who dies before receiving a first duty assignment.

- **Jun 25, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- **Jun 11, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Jun 10, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 10, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
