CECL Consumer Impact and Study Bill of 2019

This bill directs the Securities and Exchange Commission and federal financial regulators to report on the implementation of the Current Expected Credit Losses (CECL) accounting standard and its impact on credit availability, capital requirements, financial institutions, and nonfinancial institutions. Required compliance with the CECL standard is delayed until one year after submission of this report.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 28, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Commodity Exchanges, Energy, and Credit.
- **Jun 10, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 10, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Financial Services, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.

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
