### Summary (as of Jan 21, 2020)

#### Respect Graduate Student Workers Act

This bill prohibits the National Labor Relations Board from promulgating or enforcing any rule that excludes student workers at private universities from the definition of *employee* under federal labor laws. (Under current law, students paid for services provided at universities in connection with such students' studies are considered employees.)
