## Summary (as of Jun 13, 2019)

### Dynamic Glass Act of 2019

This bill classifies electrochromic glass as energy property for purposes of the investment tax credit. The bill defines "electrochromic glass" as glass which uses electricity to change its light transmittance properties to heat or cool a structure.
