Promoting Service in Transportation Act

This bill directs the Department of Transportation to establish and administer a transportation workforce outreach program to (1) increase awareness of transportation career opportunities; and (2) target awareness of professional opportunities in the transportation sector to diverse segments of the population, including with respect to race, sex, ethnicity, and socioeconomic status.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 15, 2020:** Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation. Reported by Senator Wicker with an amendment in the nature of a substitute. With written report No. 116-329.
- **Dec 15, 2020:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 635.
- **Mar 11, 2020:** Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation. Ordered to be reported with an amendment in the nature of a substitute favorably.
- **Feb 13, 2020:** Introduced in Senate
- **Feb 13, 2020:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation.
