Summary (as of Jun 21, 2019)

Television Freedom at Our Nation's Airports Act of 2019

This bill revises conditions for the approval of airport improvement grants based on airport owners or operators making certain assurances about airport operations.

Specifically, the bill

- prohibits airport owners or operators from entering into any agreement in which the content on airport television equipment is controlled by a broadcast or cable television news network, and
- prevents television equipment in an airport from being owned exclusively by any specific network.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 24, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Aviation.
- **Jun 21, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 21, 2019:** Referred to the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.
