Summary (as of Jun 25, 2019)

Kickapoo Tribe in Kansas Water Rights Settlement Act

This bill modifies and ratifies the Kickapoo Tribe Water Rights Settlement Agreement entered into by the tribe and Kansas.

The bill confirms a consumptive tribal water right in the Delaware River Basin of up to 4,705 acre-feet of water per year.

The bill also outlines waivers, releases, and retentions of claims by the tribe and the United States under the settlement agreement.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 15, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Jul 11, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife.
- **Jun 25, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 25, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
