Julia Carson Responsible Fatherhood and Healthy Families Act of 2019

This bill addresses issues related to child support and low-income families, including by reauthorizing and otherwise modifying programs funded by the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families block grant and revising the earned income tax credit.

- **Jun 26, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, and Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
