Summary (as of Jun 27, 2019)

State Cannabis Commerce Act

This bill prohibits the use of federal funds to prevent a state from implementing a law that authorizes certain marijuana-related activities.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 30, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Jun 28, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Consumer Protection and Commerce.
- **Jun 27, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 27, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
