Summary (as of Jul 15, 2019)

This bill eliminates regulatory controls and administrative, civil, and criminal penalties under the Controlled Substances Act for certain marijuana-related activities that comply with state or tribal law.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 6, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Jul 16, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 15, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 15, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
