Summary (as of Jul 16, 2019)

Advancing Emergency Preparedness Through One Health Act of 2019

This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services and the Department of Agriculture, in coordination with other specified agencies and departments, to develop, publish, and submit to Congress a national One Health Framework for coordinated federal activities under the One Health Program, which encourages collaborative efforts to help better prevent, prepare for, and respond to zoonotic disease outbreaks.

The framework must (1) describe existing efforts and contain recommendations for building upon and complementing the activities of federal entities; and (2) establish specified goals, including advancing the scientific understanding of the connections among human, animal, and environmental health.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 9, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Livestock and Foreign Agriculture.
- **Aug 2, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee for Indigenous Peoples of the United States.
- **Jul 17, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 16, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 16, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Agriculture, Natural Resources, and Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
