Safe Roads Act of 2019

This bill directs the Department of Transportation to implement motor vehicle safety standards that (1) require new commercial motor vehicles to be equipped with an automatic emergency braking system, (2) establish performance requirements for such braking systems, and (3) require such systems to be used while the commercial vehicles are in operation.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 17, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Consumer Protection and Commerce.
- **Jul 16, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 16, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
