Summary (as of May 20, 2020)

Veterans Cemetery Grants Improvement Act of 2020

This bill increases to \$10 million (currently \$5 million) the maximum amount the Department of Veterans Affairs may grant in a fiscal year to states and tribal organizations for operating and maintaining veterans' cemeteries.
