Summary (as of May 21, 2020)

Military Spouse Relocation and Contract Reimbursement Act

This bill authorizes reimbursements from the My Career Advancement Account Program account of a military spouse to pay fines imposed by an employer for breaking an employment contract in connection with the spouse's relocation due to a permanent change of station.
