Summary (as of Jan 9, 2019)

21st Century Respect Act

This bill requires the Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the General Services Administration to change the terminology used to describe the racial background or place of origin of people in regulations concerning (1) USDA programs for financing and insuring loans for properties in rural areas, and (2) the 1974 development plan for Pennsylvania Avenue in Washington, DC.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 8, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Commodity Exchanges, Energy, and Credit.
- **Jan 9, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 9, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
