#### Effective Drug Control Strategy Act

This bill requires the Office of National Drug Control Policy to (1) evaluate the effectiveness of all federally funded activities aimed at reducing the demand for illegal drugs, and (2) publish annually a complete list of all drug control grant programs.

#### Actions Timeline

---

- **Jul 19, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 18, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 18, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
