Cancer Care Planning and Communications Act of 2019

This bill provides for Medicare coverage and payment of cancer care planning and coordination services for individuals who are diagnosed with or treated for cancer, including the development of treatment plans, follow-up care, and any necessary revisions.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 19, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 18, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 18, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
