Summary (as of Jul 25, 2019)

This bill takes approximately 2,560 acres of specified lands into trust for the benefit of the Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians. Lands taken into trust shall be part of the tribe's reservation.

Under the bill, gaming is prohibited on this land.
