Summary (as of Jul 30, 2019)

Keeping HSAs Accessible Act of 2019

This bill amends the Internal Revenue Code to eliminate the ceiling on the sum of the annual deductible and out-of-pocket expenses required under a high deductible health plan (i.e., \$5,000 for self-only coverage and twice that amount for family coverage), for purposes of health saving account eligibility.
