### Summary (as of Aug 16, 2019)

#### Native American Language Vitalization Act

This bill requires the Department of Education (ED) to establish the Native American Language Vitalization and Training Program, under which ED shall award grants to eligible institutions to promote the preservation, revitalization, relevancy, and use of Native American languages.
