Paul Laurence Dunbar Commemorative Coin Act

This bill directs the Department of the Treasury to mint and issue \$5 gold coins, \$1 silver coins, and half-dollar clad coins in recognition and celebration of Paul Laurence Dunbar, one of the first influential African-American poets in American literature and the composer of the lyrics to *In Dahomey*, the first all African-American musical produced on Broadway.

All surcharges received from sales of such coins shall be paid to the Dunbar Alumni Federation.
