Summary (as of Jul 29, 2020)

This bill provides funding and establishes requirements for the Department of Agriculture to make specified payments to independent poultry growers that have experienced losses during the COVID-19 public health emergency. An *independent poultry grower* is a poultry grower that assumes the production and market risks associated with the agricultural production of poultry.
