Summary (as of Sep 19, 2019)

Clean Slate through Repayment Act of 2019

This bill requires the Department of Education (ED) to have a record of default removed from a borrower's credit history in certain circumstances.

Specifically, when a borrower repays in full the amount due on a defaulted student loan, ED must request a consumer reporting agency remove the record of default from the borrower's credit history.
