## Summary (as of Jan 10, 2019)

### Financial Protection for Our Military Families Act

This bill extends the supervisory authority of the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau to credit protections applicable to certain active duty members of the armed forces and their dependents.

## Actions Timeline

- **Jan 24, 2019:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Jan 10, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 10, 2019:** Referred to the Committee on Financial Services, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
