### Summary (as of Sep 22, 2020)

#### Angel Tax Credit Act

This bill allows a new business-related tax credit for 25% of equity investments of \$25,000 or more in a domestic corporation or partnership that (1) has its headquarters in the United States, (2) has gross revenues for the taxable year of less than \$1 million, (3) employs fewer than 25 full-time employees, (4) has been in existence for less than 7 years as of the date of the investment, (5) has more than 50% of its employees performing substantially all of their services in the United States, and (6) is engaged in a high technology trade or business. The bill limits the allowable amount of such credit to \$250,000 in any taxable year and imposes an overall limitation on such credit of \$500 million for each of calendar years 2020 through 2024.
