Summary (as of Jun 27, 2019)

Sets forth the rule for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 3401) making emergency supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 27, 2019:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 27, 2019:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 116-130, by Mr. McGovern.
- **Jun 27, 2019:** Rule provides for consideration of Senate amendment to H.R. 3401.
- **Jun 27, 2019:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 34.
- **Jun 27, 2019:** By direction of the Committee on Rules, Mr. McGovern called up H.Res. 466 and asked for its immediate consideration.
- **Jun 27, 2019:** POINT OF ORDER - Mr. Cole raised a point of order against the provisions of H.Res. 466 because it violates the Congressional Budget Act. The Chair announced the disposition of the point of order would be resolved by the question of consideration of H.Res. 466. The House proceeded with 20 minutes of debate on the point of order at the end of which the Chair will put the question on consideration.
- **Jun 27, 2019:** On consideration of the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 226 - 188 (Roll no. 425).
- **Jun 27, 2019:** DEBATE - The House resumed with debate on H.Res. 466.
- **Jun 27, 2019:** WITHDRAWAL OF RESOLUTION - Mr. McGovern withdrew the resolution from consideration.
- **Jun 27, 2019:** By the direction of the Committee on Rules, Mr. McGovern called up H. Res. 466 and asked for its immediate consideration. (consideration: CR H5223-5243; text: CR H5223)
- **Jun 27, 2019:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 466.
- **Jun 27, 2019:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 322 - 85 (Roll no. 426).
- **Jun 27, 2019:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 322 - 85 (Roll no. 426).
- **Jun 27, 2019:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
