Rebuilding a Better Child Care Infrastructure Act

This bill (1) increases funding for child care assistance under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program, (2) funds FY2021 grants for pandemic child care assistance, and (3) funds FY2022 grants to support access to child care in areas of concentrated poverty.
